

## GGNB and GAUSS Professional Skills Courses & Industry Excursions

- Registration possible two months before the course month -

**IMPORTANT:**

1) **Check** the detailed **course descriptions** in UniVZ or Stud.IP **before signing up** as some courses require pre-work / follow-up work or have an unusual duration! 2) **Participation is binding. Cancellation is only possible** via the **GGNB Office** (NOT via contacting the trainer directly) with **a) sick certificate, or b) statement by supervisor for science reasons**. If you do not provide this, you will be **excluded** from courses for the next **12 months**, as well as travel grants and other financial support. **No exceptions.**

**By signing up you agree** (1) to carefully check in advance whether you will be **able to attend** the course (e.g. do not register for 2 courses taking place on the same dates - the above mentioned sanctions apply!), (2) to **frequently check your student e-mail account**, as all information on courses will exclusively be sent to that account; (3) that your **name and e-mail address** may be **forwarded to the course instructor(s)** for communication before and after the course; (4) to complete the course **evaluation**; (5) inform us if you no longer wish to maintain a **waiting list position**; (6) that you only receive credits for attending the entire workshop - you will not get partial credits for part-time attendance.
